

## Top 10 Tips for Story Tellers

If you are planning to be a Story Teller in our Story Quest Game, here are a few tips and ideas:

1. Make sure you have registered your details with us and how you would like to be contacted – my phone, email or messaging service. You can even post written letters if you wish!
2. Every day or so, we will release a new topic to our Story Collectors who will contact you via your chosen method. If you are working directly with our team at Story Quest, then we will contact you directly.
3. If you are speaking by phone, then we hope you will be able to have a chat about the topic and maybe start to have a few ideas. Don't feel you have to answer the question straight away as we expect people to spend some time thinking about their questions. You will probably want to answer the question when you speak the following day!
4. You may want to write your thoughts down on paper. This will give you a way to note down the key points of your memory. Don't feel you have to write down everything at this stage!
5. We hope that people will script their stories and record their memories. If you are intending to do this, then you should keep your stories to one side of A4.
6. If you want to record your stories in your own voice, then check out our helpsheet with ideas how you can do this.
7. If you feel uncomfortable or upset answering any of the questions, then don't feel that you have to. There will be plenty of other questions and you may want to make up your own.
8. Don't forget to use the opportunity to talk about other matters too. Part of the aim of this game is for people to have the opportunity to talk.
9. Please let the team at Story Quest how you are getting on and if you have any other tricks and tips to share that could help others. It maybe that you also have ideas for your own questions!
10. At the end of this Quest, we hope you will have created a wonderful legacy of your personal stories that will be helpful for you and future generations as they reflect on this important time in history.
